Worcester Carnival: Saturday 1st July 2023 Road closures between 2.00pm and 5.00pm

We are writing to inform residents/businesses near our parade route that Worcester Carnival will take place on Saturday 1st July 2023. Part of the event will include a procession through the streets of Worcester, starting at 3.00pm.

To facilitate this several road closures will be in place from **2.00pm with restrictions lifted by 5.00pm**. We will be operating a rolling re-opening of the affected roads to keep disruption to a minimum.

A temporary road closure order has been granted for the event.

Residents living in Severn Terrace

Pitchcroft car park we will be restricted from 5.30pm on Friday 30th June but should not impact on your ability to park within your designated areas.

Residents near King Street (Sidbury) Car Park

Access from the end of St Peters Street will be restricted at Sidbury. We will endeavour to re-open the road network as soon as it is safe to do so, once the parade had passed. We thank you for your patience whilst

the closure is in force and recommend you make alternative arrangements during this time. Worcestershire County Council Highways Team have informed us they intend to remove the bollard restrictions in <u>Mill Street</u> temporarily to allow access to Bath Road.
